- Mendeley will import some metadata from YouTube videos, but you may have to go back and add in the author's name, date it was posted, and other information.*

Use the Zotero capture icons in your browser to import metadata from York's catalogue records. Zotero may leave out information such as the publication city and edition *

Webpages (Good)

 Zotero will import most of the metadata from webpages, but you may have to add or edit elements like publication date and author.

YouTube videos (Very Good)

- Zotero will import almost all of the metadata from YouTube videos. You may need to edit the information depending on the citation style you use. *
- * Always double-check your entries to ensure that complete details about the item have been imported. Zotero is excellent at capturing metadata from PDFs, but not as thorough with other sources.
